
# Alumni spotlight...Zeke Fenei, '07

*What we do...*

*Careful observation is one the many skills that students who take our Arts classes can develop. So many of our conversations with students revolve around “seeing”...not just looking...but seeing. Seeing the spaces between things. Seeing the relationships between things. Noticing that red comes in many different values and that there are a myriad of green hues. Noticing if a hand built ceramic vessel is balanced and symmetrical. Developing the ability to construct a composition on a simple white rectangle of photo paper that is engaging to the viewer. You will notice the word **notice** often. This is an ability that transcends the the creation of the artwork. Noticing others when you are talking with them. Noticing the weather. Noticing the light that the late day sunshine is creating through the trees. These are skills that leave the classroom with our students.*




